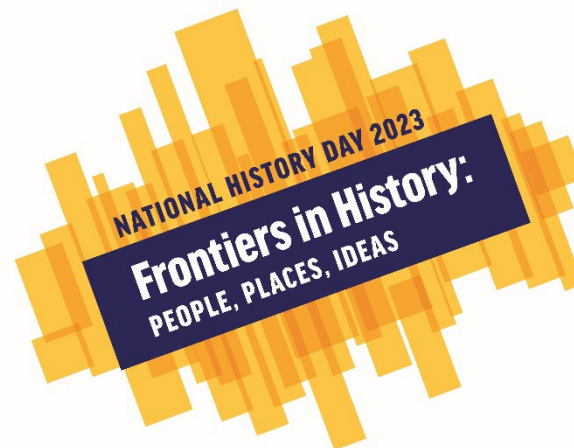

An audience is not allowed for either papers or exhibits. Exhibits will be open to the public before and after judging. No guests or additional participants will be allowed in the room during the interview period in order to keep the room quiet and free of distractions for both the students and the judges.

National Contest Qualifiers

Those ranking in 1st or 2nd place in their category will qualify to advance to the National Contest.

Those students, their families, and teacher(s) are invited to attend the qualifier meeting held immediately after the awards ceremony.

All qualifiers will receive a free qualifier t-shirt at the meeting. If students that qualify aren't present for the awards ceremony or meeting afterward, their medals, certificate(s), and t-shirts will be mailed to the school or home address provided in the registration.

Additional shirts may be available for purchase.

The national contest will be held June 11-15 at University of Maryland, College Park. Registration, payment, and submittals are due on Tuesday, May 16 before midnight – Eastern Time.

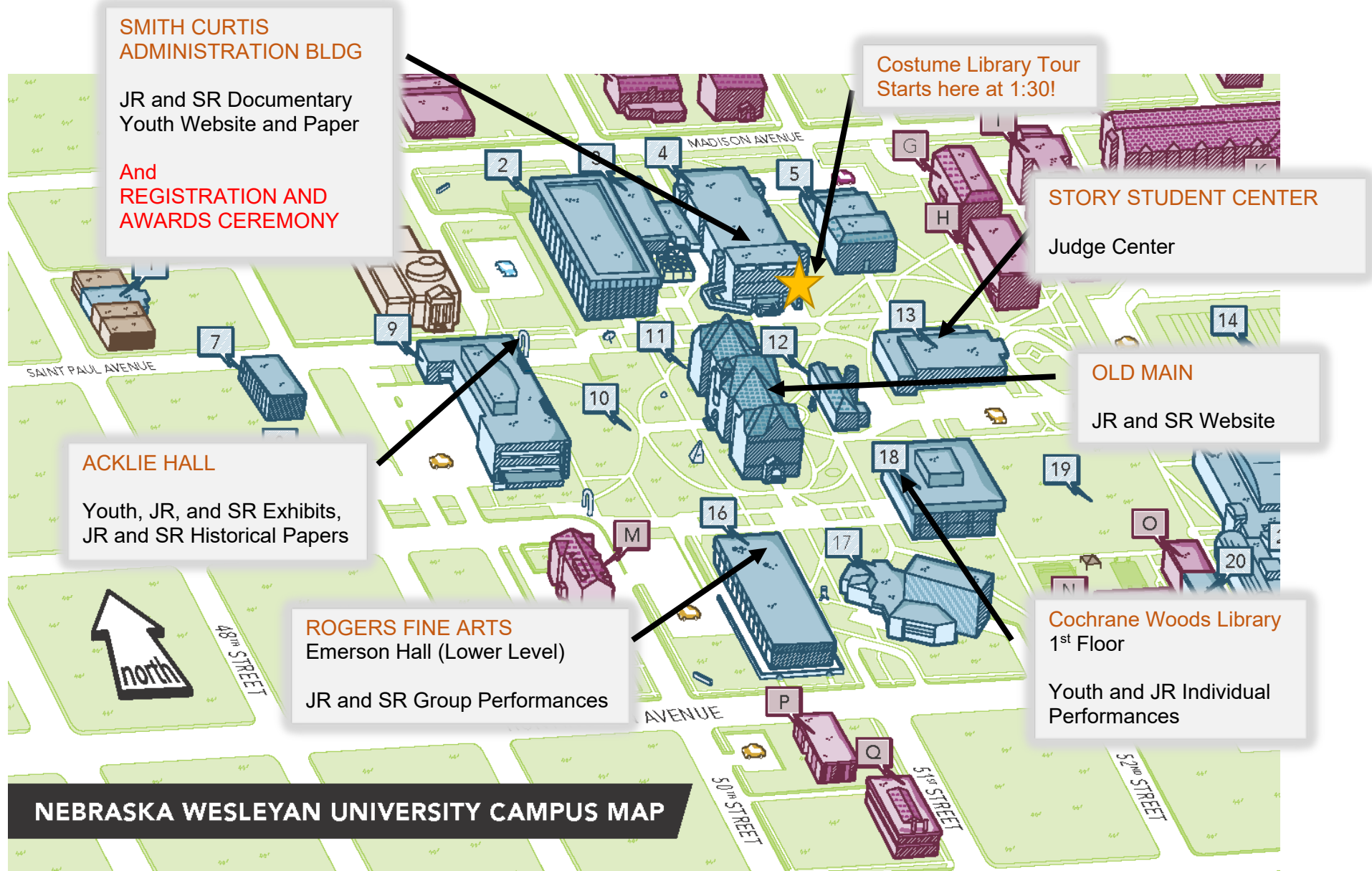
